Lyman community, Donetsk region

The Lyman community in the Donetsk region has been heavily exposed to the war. It was liberated in October 2022. From some 20,000 residents around 5,000 stayed in the town, including families with children. Schools in Lyman continue functioning despite destroyed buildings and lack of teachers. School N5 is attended by 45 children who are thought by their teacher Olga Olexandrivna in shifts in two classrooms. USB provided them with computer equipment, copy machine and some learning materials.



Along with humanitarian assistance delivered to the residents of Lyman by our partner Khaustov Fund, USB provided materials for isolation and heating for the local "Resistance centre" and most vulnerable people living in partly destroyed apartments.
